Parts of the final examination:

- a) defending the diploma work (Dw)
- b) oral final exam (OFe)

$$FeA = (Dw + OFe) / 2$$

Determining the grade of the diploma:

- a) the grade for the defence of the diploma work (Dw)
- b) the grade for the oral part of the final examination (Fe)
- c) the (two-decimal) average of the academic average of completed semesters (A)

$$(Dw + Fe + (A1 + \dots + An) / n) / 3$$

Foreign language requirements:
